Roy grew up on a ranch on the Blackfeet Indian Reservation. He still calls this ranch home, where he is raising registered quarter horses and also raises alfalfa hay for sale.

Roy is an enrolled member of the Blackfeet Tribe and worked for the Blackfeet Indian Agency, Department of Interior for 35 years. Roy is a member of the Blackfeet Conservation District.

Roy received an Associate of Arts degree in Animal Science from Harnell Jr. College in Salinas, CA and a Bachelor of Science degree in Agricultural Education from Montana State University in Bozeman. MT.

He is experienced in the conservation field and served as a Soil Conservationist, Natural Resource Specialist, Supervisory Forest Manager, and Natural Resource Officer for the Blackfeet Indian Agency. He served as Chairman of the Blackfeet Conservation District from 2011 to 2013, and was elected as Chairman of the Montana Indian State Technical Committee for USDA in 2013.
